<b>Unit of Inquiry</b>	<p>The units of inquiry are based on six transdisciplinary themes which, together, form the Programme of Inquiry (PoI). During unit of inquiry lessons, students focus on a range of subjects including language, maths, science, social studies and PSPE (Personal, Social and Physical Education), with the goal of learning subject-specific knowledge, as well as conceptual understanding and skills.</p> <p>Specialist teachers will often also connect lessons to the unit theme. The units of Inquiry are taught by Jessica Dreyer and Kate Bailey</p>
<b>Danish</b>	<p>Danish is taught in two ways: Danish Language &amp; Literature (primarily for students who have Danish a home or family language) and Danish acquisition (for students who are learning Danish as an additional language).</p> <p>Given the two Danish subjects have quite specific and different objectives, they are not two levels, but two different tracks.</p> <p>Danish acquisition is taught by Astrid McCartan, Tetiana Simonait and Dan Serritslev Danish Language &amp; Literature lessons are taught by Tina Tronier Sørensen and Anita Hjorth Volkmann</p>
<b>Assembly</b>	<p>At Assembly students gather together to build community. Every Friday P1-P3 have Assembly together. Whole School Assembly will take place once a month, on varying days.</p>
<b>Visual Art Music &amp; Drama</b>	<p>Visual Art is taught by Laura Constance and supported by Jessica Dreyer Music is taught by Karli Winters Drama is taught by Lorraine Pedersen</p>
<b>PE</b>	<p>PE is taught by Kathrin Schaller and Yusri Hassim</p>
