Unit of Inquiry	<p>The units of inquiry are based on six transdisciplinary themes which, together, form the Programme of Inquiry (PoI). During unit of inquiry lessons, students focus on a range of subjects including language, maths, science, social studies and PSPE (Personal, Social and Physical Education), with the goal of learning subject-specific knowledge, as well as conceptual understanding and skills.</p> <p>Specialist teachers will often also connect lessons to the unit theme. The units of Inquiry are taught by Saskia Blajet and John Dixon</p>
Danish	<p>Danish is taught in two ways: Danish Language & Literature (primarily for students who have Danish a home or family language) and Danish acquisition (for students who are learning Danish as an additional language).</p> <p>Given the two Danish subjects have quite specific and different objectives, they are not two levels, but two different tracks. Danish acquisition is taught by Tina Tronier Sørensen and Anita Hjorth Volkmann Danish Language & Literature lessons are taught by Astrid McCartan and Dan Serritslev</p>
