

LEARNING OUTCOMES FOR SERVICE AS ACTION

INCREASE AWARENESS OF YOUR OWN STRENGTHS AND AREAS FOR GROWTH

You will know what you are good at and what you need to improve.

By doing this type of SA activity, you will gain more understanding of the skills and abilities you have, and those you need to work on. Everyone has different abilities. Here is an opportunity to understand your own and where you need to push yourself to get better.

UNDERTAKE CHALLENGES THAT DEVELOP NEW SKILLS

You try something that is new, and learn new skills/abilities.

By doing this type of SA activity, you will challenge yourself by doing something that you have never done before. Trying new things can push us out of our comfort zone, and we will learn more skills/abilities.

INITIATE, DISCUSS, PLAN AND EVALUATE ACTIVITIES

Start a project, plan it, develop it and problem solve when things go wrong.

By doing this type of SA activity, you will be pushed to become a leader. This can be a collaborative project with others as well.

(Could be: Organizing your own fundraiser, Organizing your own awareness campaign, Teaching a course on something you're passionate about, MUN Leadership, Organizing a school event or ongoing activities, Organizing a benefit concert, Organizing a celebration day or a clean up day)

PERSEVERE IN ACTION AND COMMITMENT

Doing an activity for a long period of time, and not giving up if something is difficult.

By doing this type of SA activity, you will attend regularly and share the responsibility of solving problems.

This activity should have a significant time commitment, generally considered to be a minimum of 10 hours and a variety of actions.

(Could be: Writing and directing a performance, Organizing your own fundraiser, Organizing your own awareness campaign, Teaching a course on something you're passionate about, Organizing a school event or ongoing activities, Organizing a benefit concert, Organizing a celebration day or a clean up day)

WORK COLLABORATIVELY WITH OTHERS

Doing an activity where you have to work with other people.

By doing this type of SA activity, you will have to share roles and responsibilities with students or others.

Learning to collaborate effectively is a valuable skill. More minds are better than one.

DEVELOP INTERNATIONAL MINDEDNESS THROUGH GLOBAL ENGAGEMENT, MULTILINGUALISM AND INTERCULTURAL UNDERSTANDING

Doing an activity where you learn about global issues, different languages or cultures.

By doing this type of SA activity, you will learn about and engage with the world around you.

(Could be: Organizing a school-wide Home Language Day, Leadership during UN Day)

CONSIDER THE ETHICAL IMPLICATIONS OF YOUR ACTIONS

This is where you need to show an understanding between right and wrong.

This could be you reflecting on the types of decisions you made during an activity, or being engaged in an activity that positively affects others. Our choices impact others. Becoming aware of our decisions and the impact they have on others is an important and difficult task.
